- 16. Hosting monthly support group meetings for parents and family members
- 17. Offering free advice and support on special education issues and services in Howard County through 1:1 consultations, workshops and seminars
- 18. Funding free phone consultations with Disability Rights Maryland when needed
- 19. Partnering with the Howard County Police Department to create the 911 Flagging Program that alerts 1st responders, before they even arrive, that the person involved has ASD
- 20. Championing an Annual Transition Symposium with other disabilities organizations to strengthen the focus on transition youth
- 21. Presenting 12 annual Autism Walk & 5K events <u>and</u> 13 annual Pieces of the Puzzle Galas to support our work
- 22. Hosting Social events through the year to prevent isolation -- picnics, pool parties, fitness events, family trips, potluck dinners, sibling events, trampoline nights, bowling events and more!
- 23. Moving forward with a Housing Initiative that will offer an innovative solution to the insufficient supply of affordable, accessible housing for adults with ASD and other disabilities.
